Key Workers January 2021

Dear Parents / Carers,

Over the next 6 weeks, until February half term, your child will be attending school as part of a key worker group. The children attending school have been split into bubbles and will remain within this bubble throughout the school day. Children must attend school on the agreed dates that parents have discussed with school, via the text or phonecall.

They will complete their work at their own desk which will be spaced 2m to enable social distancing. Siblings in the same bubble may share a table. Each bubble will be supervised by 2 adults. The children will access the same remote learning as those children at home using a school laptop and the adults supervising can assist them wherever possible, whilst maintaining the appropriate distance.

On Tuesdays the children will do PE with our Grassroots teacher so should come to school wearing their PE kit, with warm clothes/tracksuit worn over.

Children may either stay for school dinners or bring a packed lunch as usual. School dinners may still be preordered on Parent Pay and the menu will stay the same as much as possible. If the menu changes, due to the produce delivered, the children will be informed.

Children attending school should be dropped off or picked up from the school office unless they are attending breakfast or after school club which will be the side gate as normal. Ad-hoc bookings for breakfast club and after school club are not being accepted at this time. School times will be 8:50am – 3:15pm. If there are parents waiting to drop off or collect children, please queue maintaining a 2m distance. Only one person may enter the office reception at one time.

If your child is unable to attend due to illness, or if they or a member of the family have Covid symptoms, please contact the school office as soon as possible.
