Remote Learning January 2021

Dear Parents / Carers,

From Wednesday 6th January resources for remote /home learning will be available for your child on our website. All children, including the key worker children attending school, will access the same resources. It is important that all children engage with the remote/home learning education that is being provided so that they don't miss out or fall behind in their learning. If your child is ill, whether they are attending as a key worker or not, it is important that you inform school so we are aware they may not be able to access learning on those days.

A range of resources will be available including, videos, powerpoints, helpsheets and activities to complete. Please refer to our Remote Learning Policy and Home Learning Overview which outlines the types of activities, how often your child should be completing work in each subject and how they can submit work and get feedback. The overview also has a number of useful weblinks with interactive books, games etc which can also help your child practice their basic skills.

All work can be accessed via the school website on the red banner at the top of the home page. Click on 'Remote Learning' then the file for your child's class. Within the class file you will find the timetable we use in school to cover all lessons during a typical week and a file for each subject. The work required for each day will be clearly dated in these files. Some videos will also be sent via FFI (Y1-6) or Tapestry (Reception). Please contact school if you do not have access to these platforms.

Try and follow the timetable as much as possible as this will help your child to keep to a routine and complete all the work set. Encourage them to take breaks as they would in school as this helps to refocus and concentrate. An exercise book for your child to record in can be collected from school if needed, alternatively children can use their own book or file from home. Work can be uploaded onto FFI / Tapestry or can be sent to a class email. This can be a photograph of the work or an attached document, e.g. Word document.

If you are unable to access the work online please contact school as soon as possible and we can arrange work packs to be printed. If your child is struggling with any of the work please contact their Class Teacher through either FFI / Tapestry or via the class email. Class Teachers will respond as soon as they can within the school day either through email or a phonecall. If your child is persistently struggling please phone school and we can discuss how we can help them further. Teachers will call every child in their class once per week. If you do not have access to Office 365, please contact school and we will issue you with an educational account to use. Please do not hesitate to contact us.
